### **DNA Format for Large Group**

One hour in length

(The order of the format is flexible. As long as the components are included, you may adjust the flow of events as you desire.)

- Welcome and open in prayer
- Worship music
- Read the 8 Principles or Christ-Centered 12 Steps, and their Biblical Comparisons
- Lesson or Testimony
  - Testimonies are to be written in advance, edited and approved by the ministry leader or other Team Member, and must be read using the approved edited version.
- Closing prayer (It is optional to close with the Serenity Prayer; however, it is highly recommended.)
- Dismissal to Open Share Groups

#### **Optional Best Practice Elements for Large Group:**

- Announcements
- Chip Ceremony
- Special music with offering or invitation
- Guest speaker or special lesson a few times a year.

## **Simple DNA Format for Open Share Group**

One hour in length, In person or online

- 1. Welcome and Leader Introductions
- 2. Open in prayer
- 3. Read the CR Small Group Guidelines
- 4. Group Open Sharing
- 5. Wrap up
- 6. Close in prayer

## **Extended DNA Format for Open Share Group**

One hour in length, In person or online

- 1. Welcome and Leader Introductions
  - 2. Open in Prayer
  - 3. Optional: Read through the 8 Principles or 12 Steps
  - 4. Read the CR Small Group Guidelines
    - a. Online groups read the additional online guidelines
  - 5. Optional: Include a 5-10 minute (max) devo or minimony
  - 6. Optional: Read the issue pamphlet related to the group's issue focus
  - 7. Optional: Ask participants to introduce themselves
  - 8. Optional: Share the focus question
  - 9. Group Open Sharing

### 10.Wrap up

- a. Optional In person: Hand out recovery chips
- b. Optional Online: Acknowledge sobriety/recovery time
- c. Optional: Take prayer requests
- d. Optional: Ask for potential sponsors to raise their hand
- e. *Optional:* Invite participants to after group fellowship and/or church events

# **DNA Format for Step Study Groups**

### 11/2 to 2 hours in length

- 1. Welcome and open in prayer
- 2. Leader and participant introductions
- 3. Read the 8 principles or Christ centered 12 steps
- 4. Read the CR Small Group Guidelines
- 5. Read the lesson acrostic from the Participant's Guide (when starting a new lesson) and take turns sharing answers to the questions.
- 6. Wrap up and close in prayer

#### **Optional Best Practice Elements for Step Study Groups:**

- Small Group Expectations (Initially, when a new Step Study begins, can be found in the ALT)
- Worship song at the beginning of the meeting
- Share a devo from the CR 365 Daily Devo or the Celebrate Recovery Bible (no more than 5 minutes, and remember, no outside curriculum
- Assign the homework questions from the Participant's Guide for next week's meeting
- Announcements
- Share prayer requests
